Each **EasyLine** kit is sufficient for **4** complete rinks and contains:

- 32 each of face off dots
- 4 each of 12" Blue Dots
- 1 Roll of 400' 12" Red Line
- 2 Rolls of 400' 12" Blue Line
- 1 Roll of 400' 2" Blue Line
- 7 Rolls of 400' 2" Red Line

ICECO's **EasyLine** Paper Line Kits are easy to use - you will have a professional looking ice surface in no time!

Equipment Required

- String or Black Thread
- 150' (45.72m) Tape Measure
- Back Pack Sprayer or Small Weed Type Sprayer
- Bucket with **hot** water
- Sponge Paint Roller with handle
- Water Hose with Fine Mist Nozzle

Applying Straight Lines (Goal line, blue and red lines)

- 1 For all straight 2" and 12" lines use a string or thread and tack to the ice surface for a reference line.
- 2 Roll out the 2" and 12" wide lines along the string or thread lines. Follow paper rolls with a wet sponge paint roller, freezing the paper onto the ice. Use only **HOT** water and insure to thoroughly saturate the paper lines.
- 3 Apply additional light cold-water mist sprays to cover the lines prior to flooding with larger hose or ice resurfer.

Applying Goal Crease, Circles and Dots

Goal Creases

Find centre point of the rink on the 2" Red Goal Line. Use a 6' radius scribe or string/cable, scribe a 6' semi circle for the goal crease. Follow the inside of the scribe line with 2" red paper line. Follow above Steps # 2 & 3. Recommend painting goal crease blue inside the goal crease once paper line is covered with water sprays.

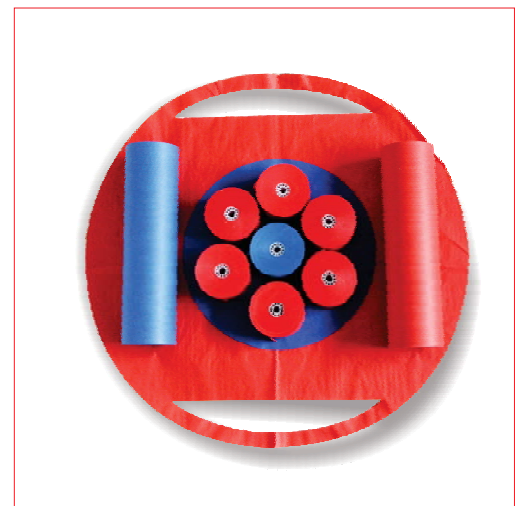
Circles

Measure to find face-off dots centres. See attached rink layouts and measurements. Use this centre point and scribe 30' (face-off) 20' (referee) diameter circle. Follow the inside of the scribe line with 2" red paper line. Follow above Steps # 2 & 3.

Dots

Once all circles are in place. Utilize the face-off dots centres and run a string/thread the length of ice intersecting centre. Tack string to ice for reference line and install 24" face-off dots with perforated half moons removed. Install remaining 2" red face-off lines and face-off 2" hash lines.

Attention: Do not wet any rolls before applying to ice. Rolls should be dry when applying. Failure to follow these instructions will result in air pockets and faded lines.



Properly maintained lines will look good for the whole season !
